

Good News to Interested Applicants!

1st Round of Admissions for the 2021/22 is Open!

The Ethiopian Graduate School of Theology (EGST) extends its invitation to interested applicants to apply for the 2021/22 academic year and join the student body of EGST.

1. Admission Requirements

- 1.1. The Post-Graduate Diploma in Biblical and Theological Studies (PGD) is open to students holding a first degree in a subject other than theology with a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- 1.2. The Master of Arts in Development Studies (MADevS) programme is open to students holding a first degree in Theology with a minimum GPA of 2.5 or in subjects other than theology with GPA of 2.0.
- 1.3. Master of Arts in Leadership and Management (MALM) programme is open to students holding a first degree in Theology with a minimum GPA of 2.5 or in subjects other than theology with GPA of 2.0.
- 1.4. The Master of Arts in Biblical and Theological Studies (MABTS) in the areas of Biblical Studies, Theological and Historical Studies, or Mission and Applied Theological Studies, is open to students holding a first degree in theology with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

2. Application Procedures

- 2.1. Application and Church Recommendation forms can be downloaded from EGST website: www.egst.edu.et . Completed application and church recommendation forms along with credentials and other required documents (see checklist below) may be submitted by e-mail to the Registrar's Office at admissions@egst.edu.et until **13 November 2020**. Applications can also be submitted in person to the Registrar's Office from Monday-Friday, **9:00 am – 5:00pm**.
- 2.2. An application fee of **300.00 ETB** must be deposited to EGST's account at:

- 2.3. All applicants are required to take IELTS or equivalent English examination to be administered by EGST to demonstrate English proficiency. Applicants are also required to take Bible and Doctrine tests to demonstrate biblical and theological competence.

Applications will be accepted only if the following documents are complete:

- 1) Completed Application form (downloadable from EGST website);
- 2) Scanned copy of Church Recommendation form completed and signed by leaders of the church of which the applicant is a member. It should also bear the church's official stamp. (downloadable from EGST website);
- 3) Personal testimony on a separate sheet (not more than 300 words);
- 4) Scanned copy of temporary or original degree;
 - ⇒ Candidates who have not settled their cost-sharing must submit a temporary degree indicating their CGPA.
- 5) Scanned copy of transcript;
- 6) Scanned copy of bank deposit slip;
- 7) Official Transcripts must be sent from the candidate's previous academic institution directly to EGST's mailing address:

NB: Hard copy of all the above documents must be submitted in person on or before entrance exam day.

Entrance Exam will be administered on Saturday, 21 November 2020.
