EGST's 2nd Round Application Extended!

1. Programmes

- 1.1. The Post-Graduate Diploma in Biblical and Theological Studies (PGD) is open to students holding a first degree in a subject other than theology with a minimum CGPA of 2.0.
- 1.2. The Master of Arts in Development Studies (MADevS) programme is open to students holding a first degree in Theology with a minimum CGPA of 2.5 or in subjects other than theology with CGPA of 2.0.
- 1.3. The Master of Arts in Peace and Sustainable Development (MA-PSD) programme is open to students holding a first degree in Theology with a minimum CGPA of 2.5 or in subjects other than theology with CGPA of 2.0.
- 1.4. Master of Arts in Leadership and Management (MALM) programme is open to students holding a first degree in Theology with a minimum CGPA of 2.5 or in subjects other than theology with CGPA of 2.0.
- 1.5. The Master of Arts in Biblical and Theological Studies (MABTS) in the areas of Biblical Studies, Theological and Historical Studies, or Mission and Applied Theological Studies, is open to students holding a first degree in theology with a minimum CGPA of 2.5.

2. Application Procedures

- 2.1. Applicants are required to take IELTS or equivalent English examination to demonstrate English proficiency. However, applicants holding a master's degree have the privilege of being exempted from the English test. Yet, all applicants are required to take Bible/Doctrine test to demonstrate biblical and theological competence.
- 2.2. Applications can be submitted in person to the Registrar's Office or electronically at admissions@egst.edu.et. Application and church recommendation forms can be downloaded from EGST website: www.egst.edu.et as of 20 June 2023.

Online applications are accepted only if the following documents are complete:

- 1) Completed application form;
- 2) Church recommendation form completed and signed by leaders of the local church of which the applicant is a member. It should also bear the church's official stamp;
- 3) Personal testimony on a separate sheet in no more than 300 words;
- 4) Scanned copy of temporary or original degree.
 - ⇒ Candidates who have not settled their cost-sharing must submit a temporary degree indicating their CGPA.
- 5) Scanned copy of transcript.
- 6) Scanned copy of bank deposit slip.
- 7) Official Transcripts must be sent from the candidate's previous academic institution directly to EGST's mailing address:

NB: For applications submitted by email, hard copies of all the above documents must be submitted in person on or before the entrance exam date.

Applications are considered only from recognized academic institutions.

Entrance exam will be administered on Saturday, 12 August 2023.
